Memory Verse: Philippians 4:6

Big Idea: Because Jesus loves me, I can always talk with Him in prayer.

Week 1: Planting Your Prayer Seed

Main Idea: Connecting with Jesus through daily prayers can lead to spiritual growth. **Bible Story:** The Mustard Seed (Matthew 17:20)

Learning Objective: Students will learn that beginning a daily prayer is like sowing a seed, and growing a closer relationship with Jesus.

Week 2: Nurturing Your Prayer Life

Main Idea: Establishing and maintaining a consistent prayer life strengthens our

relationship with Christ and draws us closer to Him every day.

Bible Story: Daniel's Unwavering Prayer Life (Daniel 6:10-23)

Learning Objective: Students will learn that consistent prayer, like watering a plant, grows a strong relationship with Jesus.

Week 3: Overcoming Prayer Obstacles

Main Idea: Prayer to Jesus strengthens our relationship with Him, even in tough times. Bible Story: Jonah's Reluctance and Redemption (Jonah 1-3)

Learning Objective: Students will understand that challenges and distractions are opportunities to strengthen their prayer life.

Week 4: Harvesting the Blessings

Main Idea: Expressing gratitude can strengthen our relationship with Jesus.

Bible Story: The Grateful Leper (Luke 17:11-19)

Learning Objective: Students will celebrate the blessings that come from a consistent prayer life and learn the importance of gratitude.

Each lesson includes various engaging activities for children, such as group games, object lessons, interactive Bible stories, memory verse exercises, teaching skits, discussion guides, craft activities, word searches, and coloring pages.



Prayer Challenge

We're starting a Pumpkin Prayer Challenge! Each week we'll learn a new way to pray and get closer to Jesus. You'll find 7 fun and simple activities to help you pray every day of the week. Bring your tracker back next week to share how it's going. We want to help you make prayer a daily habit, something as normal as brushing your teeth but way more exciting because you get to talk directly to God!

Week 1: Planting Your Prayer Seed

- Sunday: Say a morning prayer asking God to help you focus on Him throughout the week. (You can do this in class today).
- □ Monday: Draw a "prayer seed" and write one thing you'll pray for this week.
- □ Tuesday: Pray before lunch for the people who prepared your food.
- □ Wednesday: Pray for your teachers and friends at school.
- □ Thursday: Pray for your family members individually.
- Friday: Say a bedtime prayer, thanking God for getting you through the week.
- □ Saturday: Review your "prayer seed" and notice if there has been any change or answer to your prayer.





- □ Thursday: Write down or draw something you're thankful for.
- □ Friday: Pray for peace and rest in your home.
- Saturday: Reflect on your week and say a prayer thanking God for his guidance.




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Daniel's Unwavering Prayer Life


Week 3: Overcoming Prayer Obstacles


- □ Sunday: Pray for a willingness to overcome challenges this week.


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

Week 4: Harvesting the Blessings


- Sunday: Begin your day with a prayer of anticipation for the week's blessings.

- □ Saturday: Reflect on the week's blessings and say a prayer of gratitude.



"The Pumpkin Prayer" Activity & Devotional for Pumpkin Carving

This time of year brings about a holiday that is often met with controversy within the church. Some people choose to embrace Halloween and some people choose to oppose it.

Some churches host <u>fall festivals</u>, some hold <u>trunk-or-treats</u>, and some don't acknowledge the holiday

at all. Whether you choose to celebrate or not is up to your family and church. However, if you do choose to participate in the Halloween holiday, here's a way to celebrate from a Christian perspective.

Materials needed: pumpkin for carving, carving tools, trash bags, a copy of pumpkin prayer, candle for pumpkin, Bible

Some of you may have heard of or even read the pumpkin prayer before. It is a fun way to carve a pumpkin with your family or even in your children's church time. As you begin to carve your pumpkin, read the poem below. You can look up corresponding scripture ahead of time to read as you carve your pumpkin.

(If you want to leave in a classroom for an extended period of time, you can use a sharpie marker to draw the features on the pumpkin, just remember to explain that normally we would clean out a pumpkin when carving it and how that correlates to God cleaning out the sin from our lives).

Type or write out Matthew 5:16 and attach it to the stem of the pumpkin as a reminder to live our lives for God and his glory.



The Pumpkin Prayer

Dear Jesus,

As I carve my pumpkin, help me pray this prayer: Open my mind so that I can learn about You; (cut the top off the pumpkin) Take all my sin and forgive the wrong that I do. (clean out the inside) Open my eyes so Your love I will see; (cut eyes shaped like hearts) I'm sorry for times I've turned up my nose at what You've given to me. (cut a nose in the shape of a cross) Open my ears so Your word I will hear; (cut ears shaped like a Bible) Open my mouth to tell others You're near. (cut the mouth in the shape of a fish) Let Your light shine in all I say and do! (place candle inside and light it)
