# Wonder Kids: 5-Week Curriculum Schedule

## Week 1 – God Talks to Me!

- **Bible Story:** Samuel Hears God's Voice (1 Samuel 3)
- **Summary:** God talks to kids, and He loves it when we listen! Just like Samuel, we can learn to hear God's voice and follow Him.

## Week 2 – God Helps Me Help Others!

- **Bible Story:** Miriam Protects Moses (Exodus 2:1-10)
- **Summary:** God gives kids courage and love to help others. Just like Miriam helped her baby brother, we can help people too because God is with us!

## Week 3 – I Can Tell Others About God!

- **Bible Story:** Naaman's Servant Girl (2 Kings 5:1-14)
- **Summary:** Even small voices can tell big truths! This week we learn that we can share God's love and kindness, just like the brave little servant girl.

## Week 4 – Jesus Uses What I Give!

- **Bible Story:** Loaves and Fishes (John 6:1-14)
- **Summary:** When we give what we have, Jesus can do amazing things! Just like a boy shared his lunch, we can give and watch Jesus do miracles.

## Week 5 – I Can Learn About God!

- **Bible Story:** Young Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-52)
- **Summary:** Learning about God is important—no matter how small we are! Jesus learned about God when He was young, and we can too.

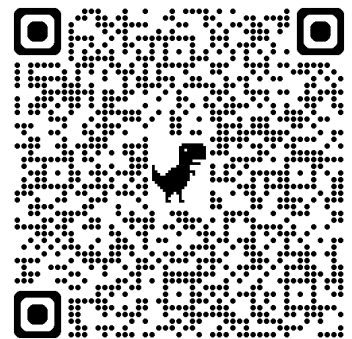

# Week 1 - Supply List

---

## Arrival & Guided Play

- Toy phones or walkie-talkies
- Stuffed animals
- Blocks or Duplos
- Flashlights
- Small bed or pillow area

## Craft Activity: Samuel's Listening Ears

- Long paper strips (for headbands)
- Pre-cut large paper ear shapes (2 per child) template provided below
- Crayons or markers
- Tape or child-safe glue

# Arrival and Guided Play (5-10 minutes)

---

Welcome each child with a big smile and invite them to explore the classroom play area. This week we're learning God talks to me! and hearing the story of Samuel Hears God's Voice. Use these simple activities to gently introduce the idea that God loves to talk to us—even when we're little!

## Toy/Activity Ideas & Teacher Talking Points

- **Toy Phones or Walkie-Talkies** – Let's call someone! Hello? Can you hear me? Samuel heard someone calling him too—it was God!
- **Stuffed Animals** – Let's tuck our animals in for bedtime. Shhh, they're sleeping! That's when Samuel heard God's voice—when he was resting!
- **Blocks or Duplos** – Let's build a little house! Maybe it's like the place where Samuel lived with Eli. That's where God talked to him.
- **Flashlights** – Let's turn on the light in the dark. Samuel heard God's voice in the night when it was dark too!
- **Small Bed or Pillow Corner** – Let's lay down and be very still. What do you hear? Samuel was quiet, and he heard something very special—God speaking to him!

**Transition to Group Game:** Let's clean up our toys and come sit in a circle to play a game together!

# Group Games (5 minutes) Simon Says

---

## Setup:

- Clear a space where children can stand and move safely.

**TEACHER:** Let's play a fun game called *Simon Says!* You have to listen closely to know what to do—just like a boy named Samuel in the Bible listened when God spoke to him.

If I say "Simon says, touch your nose!" then you do it! But if I just say "Touch your nose," and I don't say *Simon says*—you stay still! Let's practice together!

## Example commands:

- Simon says, jump up and down!
- Simon says, spin in a circle!
- Touch your toes!
- Uh-oh! I didn't say Simon says!



# Bible Story (10 minutes)

## Samuel Hears God's Voice (1 Samuel 3)

---

**Lesson Main Idea:** God talks to me!

**Summary:** God talks to kids, and He loves it when we listen! Just like Samuel, we can learn to hear God's voice and follow Him.

**Supplies Needed:**

- Printed picture of a child lying in bed with eyes wide open (illustration provided)
- Printed picture of Eli, the older priest, looking surprised (illustration provided)
- Printed picture of Samuel standing with a big smile and open hands (illustration provided)

**TEACHER:** Let's get ready for a Bible story about a little boy named Samuel. Samuel was just a kid—maybe like you!

*Show the picture of "Samuel lying in bed with eyes wide open."*

Samuel lived in God's house with a kind old man named Eli. At night Samuel would lie on his little bed. Can you lie down and close your eyes like you're sleeping?

One night, while Samuel was resting... he heard something. A voice said, "Samuel! Samuel!" Samuel sat up! He thought Eli was calling him.

*Show the picture of Eli looking surprised.*

He ran to Eli and said, "Here I am!" But Eli said, "I didn't call you. Go back to bed."

So Samuel laid down again... Then he heard it again—"Samuel! Samuel!" He ran to Eli again, but Eli still didn't call him. Can you guess who was talking to Samuel?

That's right—it was GOD!

Eli finally said, "If you hear the voice again, say, 'Speak, Lord. I'm listening.'"

So Samuel laid down again. And guess what? He heard it again! "Samuel! Samuel!"

Samuel said, "Speak, Lord. I'm listening!"

*Show the picture of Samuel standing with a big smile and open hands.*

God talked to Samuel! God gave him a special message. Samuel listened—and that made God happy. God loved talking to Samuel. And guess what? God loves talking to you too!

Let's say it together: God talks to me!

God might not talk out loud like He did with Samuel, but He talks through the Bible, our teachers, and in our hearts. If we listen—He helps us hear Him.

### **PRAYER TIME:**

Let's talk to God together. You can repeat after me.

Dear God,

Thank You for loving me.

Thank You for speaking to Samuel.

Help me to listen to You too.

I want to hear Your voice.

In Jesus Name, Amen.

# Craft (10 minutes)

## Samuel's Listening Ears

---

### Supplies Needed:

- Long paper strips (for headbands)
- Pre-cut large paper ear shapes (2 per child)  
template below
- Crayons or markers
- Tape or child-safe glue



**TEACHER:** Let's make some big listening ears—just like Samuel needed when God called his name!

*Give each child a headband strip and two large ear shapes.*

Use your crayons to decorate your ears however you like. You can make them colorful, spotted, or even sparkly!

Now we'll tape our ears onto the headband so you can wear them.

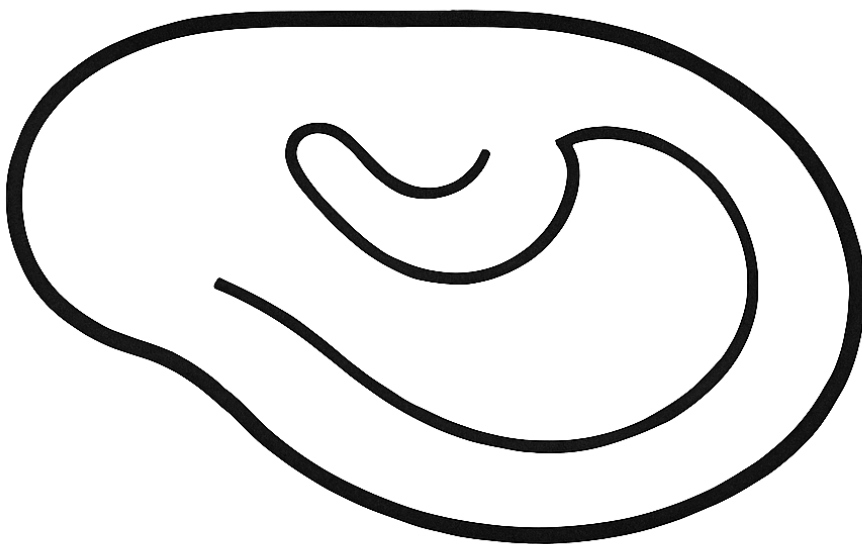
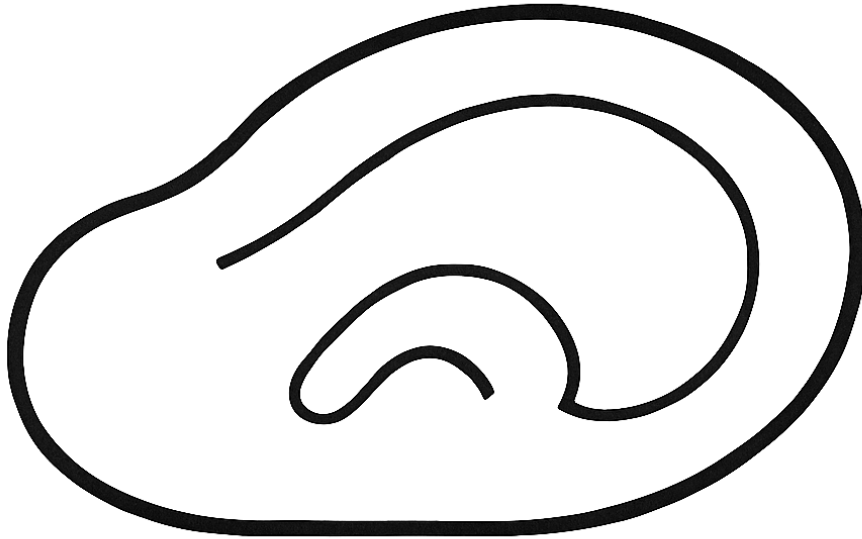
Let's try them on—WOW! Look at all those big ears!

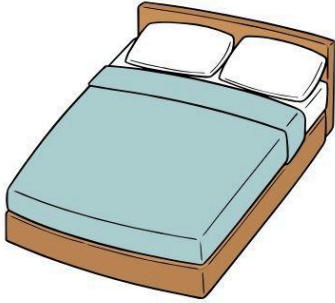

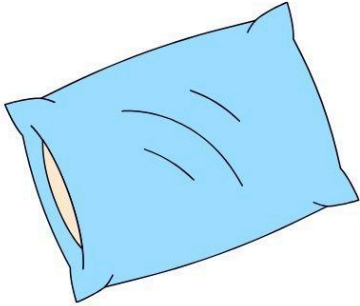
