Types of CPAP Machines



Auto-Adjusting CPAP (APAP)



What is an APAP?

APAPs automatically adjust pressure based on your breathing needs throughout the night.

Who are APAPs for?

APAPs are ideal for those with varying pressure requirements or who are new to CPAP therapy.

If you used our Home Sleep Test, your prescription likely includes an APAP machine with a range of pressure settings.

Non-Adjusting or Fixed-Pressure CPAP



What is a CPAP?

CPAP machines deliver consistent, fixed pressure all night long.

Who are CPAPs for?

CPAPs are perfect for experienced users who know their exact pressure needs.

Lab sleep tests may prescribe a fixed pressure. APAP machines can run in CPAP mode, but CPAP machines can't switch to APAP mode.

Bi-Level (BiPAP)



What is a BiPAP?

BiPAP machines offer two distinct pressures for inhaling and exhaling.

Who are BiPAPs for?

BiPAPs are best suited for those who need higher pressure settings or have difficulty exhaling against pressure.

Bipap therapy is often used for people with complex conditions that affect breathing. These machines provide extra support while breathing in and out.

Essential CPAP Features

Noise Level

With noise levels comparable to soft rainfall, today's CPAP machines are designed to fade into the background of your sleep environment.

Humidification

Many modern CPAP machines include integrated, adjustable, and heated humidification systems to combat dryness and keep you comfortable all night long.

Mask Compatibility

Most CPAP machines use standardized connections and are compatible with most CPAP masks. An exception to this is the ResMed AirMini, which is designed to work with only a select few ResMed masks.

Exhalation Relief

Goes by many names, but this feature lowers pressure during exhalation to make therapy easier and breathing feel more natural.

Humidifier Pre-Heat

Warms your humidifier so therapy air is just how you like it on the first breath.

Portability

If you travel frequently, consider a lightweight travel-sized CPAP machine. They're not as quiet as full-sized machines, but still have similar comfort features.

Data and Connectivity

Modern CPAP machines track therapy data which you can view directly on the machine or via a smartphone companion app. Compliance data can be transferred through the app or via SD card.

Ramp Mode

Starts you at a low pressure and ramps up to your prescribed pressure over time. Some machines can detect and wait until you're asleep.

Auto Start/Stop

Some machines can be touchless. When you put on your mask and take a breath, therapy will start. It will also stop moments after removing your mask.

Mask Fit Check

Uses pressure to check your mask for leaks before starting therapy.
